## APPLICATION PROCESS

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Each NPTC fleet member company is eligible to nominate one driver per year (a leased driver must be nominated by the member fleet employing the driver). Applicants must be a regularly employed, full-time company, or leased driver and actively driving for the 12-month period beginning June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2022. Also required is a current Motor Vehicle Record for the last ten (10) years or the maximum period available in your state (dated within 30 days of application submission).

### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Online applications must be submitted by Friday, June 24, 2022. You will receive an email confirmation once the application is submitted. If you do not receive an email within 24 hours, please email [sporter@nptc.org](mailto:sporter@nptc.org) to verify that NPTC received the completed application. NPTC cannot be held liable for applications that have not been acknowledged.

### JUDGING PROCESS

Specific metrics of nomination include:

- Customer service (uniform/appearance; on-time deliveries; attitude/conduct; customer feedback; loading/unloading; cooperation)
- Safety (number of DOT reportable accidents; number of OSHA reportable injuries; number of traffic violations verified by current MVR)
- Compliance with company standards (attendance, attendance at safety meetings, training, paperwork, etc.)
- Regulatory compliance (hours of service, DVIR, MVR, etc.)
- Community Service

Drivers that meet or exceed the standards as enumerated here will be evaluated on the merits of their eligibility against internal corporate standards. The eligibility guidelines recognize that standards vary company to company. This program recognizes a driver's performance against the internal high standards of the member company as opposed to some arbitrary industry standard.

Winning applicants will be notified by July 15, 2022.

## RECOGNITION

Drivers selected as a 2022 NPTC National Driver All-Star will be announced and honored during the National Safety Conference (held at the Omni Championsgate Hotel in Orlando, FL) on Thursday, September 8, 2022. Winning drivers and company representatives attending only the recognition ceremony are invited to attend at no cost. However, if the driver and/or company representatives will be attending the entire conference, which is encouraged, the charge will be \$495 per person.

## SAFETY

1. Number of DOT Reportable Accidents: DOT Reportable Accident means an occurrence involving a commercial motor vehicle that involves: i. A fatality; ii. Bodily injury to a person who, as a result of the injury, immediately receives medical treatment away from the scene of the accident; or iii. One or more motor vehicles incurring disabling damage as a result of the accident, requiring the motor vehicle(s) to be transported away from the scene by a tow truck or other motor vehicle.
2. Preventable Accidents: A preventable accident is one wherein the driver failed to act in a reasonably expected manner to prevent it.
3. Non-Preventable Accidents: A non-preventable is one that the driver did everything reasonable to avoid it.
4. Number of OSHA Reportable Injuries
5. Provide explanation of accidents including injuries/fatalities, vehicles involved, preventable/non-preventable/chargeable, citations issued.
6. Please explain performance meeting or exceeding corporate safety standards that demonstrate driver's commitment to safety.

## CURRENT MOTOR VEHICLE RECORD

Applicants are required to upload a copy of the applicant's current Motor Vehicle Record for the last ten years or the maximum period available (dated within 30 days of application submission).\*

## REGULATORY COMPLIANCE
