Q. We are exploring the feasibility of setting up a sleep apnea program and wanted to know what other fleets had experienced in determining testing requirements, payment options, and treatment options.

A. Put simply, sleep apnea occurs when the airway is blocked during sleep. People move their diaphragm and chest in an attempt to breathe, but their throat is blocked, which stops any air from reaching the lungs. After a few seconds, the oxygen in the blood falls to

critical levels, and the person wakes up gasping for air. Some of the risk factors for developing sleep apnea include being overweight, having a neck circumference of 17" or greater, heavy snoring, headaches upon waking, and daytime sleepiness. The consequences of untreated sleep apnea include twice as many traffic accidents, twice the healthcare cost, 50% increase in hospital stays, an elevated risk of cardiovascular disease, heart attack, stroke, and much more. We estimate that about one-third of commercial drivers suffer

with untreated sleep apnea.


