2007 BENCHMARKING SURVEY

For more than two out of three private fleets, the primary reason they exist is to provide customer service on behalf of their company, according to preliminary results of the 2007 Benchmarking Survey conducted by NPTC. As a result, most private fleets concentrate on outbound deliveries where product integrity, quality and timeliness reign supreme. Highlights of the survey follow:

- The leading challenges for private fleets, not surprisingly, were coping with rising fuel prices and attracting and retaining drivers.
- Nevertheless, despite continuing reports of triple-digit turnover in the for-hire sector, NPTC members reported a turnover rate of 14%.
- More than half of the respondents reported running a slip seat operation in their private fleet.
- Nearly three quarters of the private fleet respondents (72%) reported plans to increase the size of their fleet over the next five years.
- Some 42% of the private fleets reported blending in dedicated contract carriers to handle a portion of the company freight.
