DRIVER HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

Four truck drivers who have logged more than a combined 145 years and 16.1 million miles of safe driving were honored by the National Private Truck Council and inducted into the NPTC Driver Hall of Fame during the Annual Education Management Conference and Exhibition held April 18-20, 2010, in Cincinnati.

The drivers are from NPTC member companies and have met the minimum qualifications of 20 years, 2 million miles or 50,000 hours of driving without a preventable accident. Many of the drivers have far exceeded these qualifications and are known for having made significant contributions to their industry and their communities. Since its inception, 96 drivers have been installed in the Driver Hall of Fame.

In addition, Denis Litalien, a driver with Clifford W. Perham Inc., operating out of Biddeford, ME, received the NPTC Humanitarian Award. Currently, he serves as president and executive director of the Maine Professional Drivers Association, a group he founded more than 20 years ago to promote courtesy, safety and professionalism in the field of truck driving.
