# WEBCAST – "DRIVER PAY & PRODUCTIVITY," PART II

Following on the heels of the two highly successful technology webcasts focusing on "Performance Management Technology" and one on the hours-of-service decision, NPTC and J.J. Keller & Associates are busy planning the next round of webcasts which will focus on case studies of private fleet companies that have demonstrated success in implementing technology in specific areas of private fleet operations.

#### **NATIONAL SAFETY CONFERENCE 2007**

A record crowd of more than 130 fleet operations and safety managers from more than 50 transportation companies convened in Arlington, Virginia for NPTC's fifth annual National Safety Conference, September 13-14, 2007.

Attendees heard about how driving history predicts future crashes by Dan Murray of American Transportation Research Institute. Jay Sterrett of Mohawk Industries took that predictive modeling a step further to show how his company analyzes accident data to develop more effective safety strategies.

In one of the highlights of the conference, attendees learned about the advantage of including safety in the recruiting, hiring and training from two NPTC Driver Hall of Fame inductees, Ernest Woodruff, Smithfield Transportation, and James Tolly, who retired from NCI Building Systems, in addition to fleet managers Gordon Worell of Smithfield Transportation and Larry Dean, CTP, of NCI Building Systems.

FMCSA field inspector Michael Fox and NPTC's General Counsel Rick Schweitzer provided regulatory and enforcement updates, while Jim Noble of Zurich Insurance demonstrated the value of NPTC Best Practices Safety Guide.

A panel of industry experts shared the latest technological advances in areas of collision mitigation, lane departure warning, and stability control. Panelists included Amy Houser, FMCSA; Alan Korn, Meritor Wabco; William J. Patrolia, Iteris; Kevin Romanchok, Bendix-Commercial Vehicle Systems; and RickYoungblood, Eaton-Vorad.

Finally, Leesa Mansen of Smith Systems Driver Improvement Institute, Inc. talked about driver training and Dr Timothy Lee., MD, Medical Director, Sentara OBICI Occupational Health Services, described how private fleets can improve their safety by encouraging drivers to invest in healthy lifestyles.

Candidates for the Certified Transportation Professional® (CTP) program are encouraged to register now for their places in the Class of 2008. The Eligibility Application deadline is October 1, 2007.

By earning the CTP designation, you join a group of transportation professionals who have made a commitment to the private fleet industry, to an ongoing pursuit of career advancement, and to continuing enhancement of their knowledge and skills.
