2020 NATIONAL DRIVER ALL-STARS APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Each NPTC fleet member company is eligible to nominate one driver per year. Applicants must be a regularly employed, full-time company or leased driver and actively driving for the 12-month period beginning June 1, 2019 through May 31, 2020. A current Motor Vehicle Record for the past three years is also required.

RULES

- A company may nominate one (1) driver per year.
- A leased driver must be nominated by the member fleet employing the driver
- Sections I V must be completed.
- Nomination forms must have the signatures of the nominated driver, a safety representative and a corporate officer.

DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this award, an accident is defined as any event in which a commercial vehicle was involved, (unless unattended and properly parked), regardless of the extent of damage (bodily, vehicle, or property) or where it occurred (public or private property). Please see a full list of definitions within this application in the footnotes of the application.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Nomination forms and a **certified copy of the applicant's driving record** must be emailed to **sporter@nptc.org** by the close of business **Friday**, **June 30**, **2020**. You will receive an email confirmation of receipt of the application within 24 hours. If you do not receive an email within 24 hours, please follow up to verify that NPTC received the completed application. NPTC cannot be held liable for applications that have not been acknowledged.

JUDGING PROCESS

Specific metrics of nomination include:

- Customer service (uniform/appearance; on-time deliveries; attitude/conduct; customer feedback; loading/unloading; cooperation)
- Safety (number of DOT reportable accidents; number of OSHA reportable injuries; number of traffic violations verified by current MVR)
- Compliance with company standards (attendance, attendance at safety meetings, training, paperwork, etc.)
- Regulatory compliance (hours of service, DVIR, MVR, etc.)
- Community Service

Drivers that meet or exceed the standards as enumerated here will be evaluated on the merits of their eligibility against internal corporate standards. The eligibility guidelines recognize that standards vary company to company. This program recognizes a driver's performance against the internal high standards of the member company as opposed to some arbitrary industry standard.

RECOGNITION PROCESS

Drivers selected as a 2020 NPTC National Driver All-Star will be announced and honored during the National Safety Conference (held at the Omni Championsgate Hotel in Orlando, FL) on Thursday, September 10, 2020. Winning drivers and company representatives attending only the recognition ceremony are invited to attend at no cost. However, if the driver and/or company representatives will be attending the entire conference, which is encouraged, the charge will be \$495 per person.

DEFINITIONS:

[1] DOT Reportable Accident means – Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this definition, an occurrence involving a commercial
 i. A fatality;

- ii. Bodily injury to a person who, as a result of the injury, immediately receives medical treatment away from the scene of the accident; or
- iii. One or more motor vehicles incurring disabling damage as a result of the accident, requiring the motor vehicle(s) to be transported away from the scene by a tow truck or other motor vehicle.

^[2] A preventable accident is one wherein the driver failed to act in a reasonably expected manner to prevent it.

^[3] A non-preventable is one that the driver did everything reasonable to avoid it.

^[4] A copy of the MVR is to be attached to the All-Star Application with no violations.

^[5] The All-Star applicant must comply with the Hours of Service rules and regulations as set forth in the FMCSR 395 with no violations.

^[6] Has the All-Star applicant completed a Pre-Trip and Post-Trip Inspection as required in the FMCSA 396? The regulations require a driver to report in writing at the completion of each day's work on each vehicle operated.

^[7] Does the company have a speed policy and how is it enforced? Example: Onboard computers are monitored daily, weekly or monthly. Has the applicant completed the year without a speed violation?

SECTION IV: Certification – Application must include all signatures to be eligible
